What started as an "if you know, you know" event, the TD Amplify series is blazing a creative path through the centre of Calgary's arts landscape, inviting audiences to be the first to experience the leading edge of what's new in our local scene. It's been called "a rich inclusion of culture, identity, and expression" that is "beyond expectations" and "phenomenal!" and audiences are invited to be part of the energy in the underground Engineered Air Theatre afterparty.

Wakefield Brewster Presents, Pt. 4, features four names iconic to their fields in Calgary: comedian Jeremy Furlong who has had Calgarians laughing since 2005, writer and evocative visual artist John F. Gerrard, dancer and Decidedly Jazz Danceworks company member Kaja Irwin, and multi-award-winning musician and public speaker Chloe Stankowski. And Wakefield Brewster himself will return with his newest creative adventure - *PoeThree* - to cap off this evening showcasing local talent.

"Wakefield has set the creative bar very high for the artist cohort this season, and if the energy, applause, after parties are any indication of the success of this final edition, I think it's fair to say that it'll be something to remember," says Joshua Dalledonne, Associate Director of Creative at Arts Commons. "It's an honour and a privilege to support and amplify these artists with their fans, friends, and family and we're incredibly grateful for their trust in us to do just that."

Calgary Poet Laureate and curator of the TD Incubator program, Wakefield Brewster, brought "people puzzle" his unique theme to the 2023-24 season of the TD Amplify series. Through a year of development with their fellow artists, Brewster's vision saw the artists gaining new pieces and discarded others, stepping forward with a version of themselves altered by their collaborative time together.

"It's a celebration because it's a graduation from everything that we've accomplished together this year," says Wakefield Brewster. "We have all grown through this process and in many ways, I'm taking away as many learnings as I've shared. Nothing in my life can compare to what I've experienced with these artists this past season, and it's my hope that they feel the same."

The performers of the TD Amplify series are members of the TD Incubator artist development program, which provides performance and exhibition opportunities in addition to networking, professional development, and mentorship. Each season of TD Incubator is guided by the leadership of the program Fellow(s), which have previously included Jae Sterling and Contra, and Sargeant x Comrade. Arts Commons is thrilled to have continued this outstanding artistic
