During construction of both phases of the Arts Commons Transformation (ACT) project, an estimated \$386 Million^[1] will be added to Calgary's Gross Domestic Product. In addition, 3,155 Jobs^[1] will be created that will generate \$239 Million^[1] in Labour Income. Contributions to government revenues (taxes) as a direct result of ACT is estimated to be \$11 Million^[1] to The City of Calgary.

Upon completion of both phases of construction, collectively with the resident companies, Arts Commons will annually generate \$53 Million^[1] to Calgary's GDP, and support 683 jobs that will generate \$34 Million^[1] in Labour Income. Annual contributions to The City of Calgary's revenues (taxes) is estimated to be \$1.2 Million^[1].
